

Inflammatory Bowel Disease Standardized Care Protocols

13. IRON SUCROSE INFUSION

Physician:

1. Review CBC (hemoglobin), Fe, Ferritin, FeSAT, TIBC.
2. Based on the results, should you feel the patient needs replacement, send a message to the IBD Nurse to let them know this patient will need iron sucrose infusion.

Nurse:

1. Send the Iron Sucrose Patient Care Orders ([#1](#)) to the Zeidler Clinic Staff (Edmonton)/day medicine (Calgary) ([#1](#) & [#2](#)).

Clinic Staff:

1. Schedule 5 weekly iron infusion appointments at the KAYE Edmonton clinic/day medicine (Calgary) for the patient and fax the orders over to the KAYE Edmonton clinic/day medicine (Calgary).
2. Take the orders down to the physician support staff.

Support Staff:

1. Use the iron replacement letter templates to send one letter to the patient's GP ([#2](#)) and one to the patient ([#3](#)).
2. In the patient mailing/email also include the Patient Instructions ([#4](#)), with appointment times listed and the follow-up bloodwork requisition to be done two months following his/her last infusion ([#5](#)).
3. Return the orders to the nurses.
