

SPORT GI TRIAGE CODES

1	GI Bleeds (acute) (melena, hematemesis)
2	Rectal bleeding
3	Iron deficiency anemia <u>or</u> Sudden, unexpected anemia
4	Screening for colon cancer - no risk factors
5	Screening for colon cancer - positive family history of colon cancer or polyps
6	Previous colonic polyps or colon cancer
7	FOBT positive stools
8	Change in bowel habit
9	Constipation (chronic)
10	Abnormality seen on barium enema or colonoscopy
11	Diverticulitis (suspicion of)
12	GERD
13	Surveillance for Barrett's esophagus
14	Dyspepsia
15	Dyspepsia/ GERD not responding to PPI <u>or</u> Dyspepsia/GERD with presence of alarm symptoms <u>or</u> Dyspepsia with age criteria 15a) acute 15b) chronic
16	Dysphagia 16a) Progressive 16b) Stable
17	Abnormality seen on upper GI series or suspicion of PUD (peptic ulcer disease) 17a) suspicion of cancer 17b) other
18	Chest pain, noncardiac
19	Weight loss

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20	Abdominal pain 20a) Chronic >6 months 20b) New onset <6 months
21	Diarrhea
22	Crohn's disease 22a) Newly diagnosed or Flare up 22b) Stable
23	Ulcerative colitis 23a) Newly diagnosed or Flare up 23b) Stable
24	Symptoms suggestive of IBD/bloody diarrhea
25	Celiac disease (suspicion of)
26	Symptoms suggestive of IBS
27	Pancreatitis or pancreatic abnormalities
28	Gallstones
29	Referral for ERCP
30	Referral for EUS
31	Referral for capsule endoscopy
32	Abnormalities in the biliary tract, gallbladder, or pancreas
33	Abnormal liver enzymes
